

**\*\*JZ Modifier Letter Guidelines:\*\***

1. **\*\*Purpose\*\***: Used to indicate specific phonetic qualities or modifications.
2. **\*\*Placement\*\***: Follow the base letter or consonant.
3. **\*\*Usage\*\***: Typically used in linguistic studies, phonetics, and orthographic transcriptions.
