To find the Position based on the ID from Table 1, you would use the
following VLOOKUP formula in cell C2 of Table 1:
=VLOOKUP(A2, D:E, 2, FALSE)
This formula looks up the ID in cell A2 of Table 1 within the range D:E
of Table 2, returning the corresponding Position from the second column.
